The world has witnessed the critical importance of immunisation

Through immunisation we have:

- ✓ Eradicated smallpox
- ✓ Significantly reduced polio
- Reduced and controlled measles, rubella, tetanus, diphtheria, mumps, pertussis
- ✓ Contained the COVID-19 pandemic

Immunisation is a powerful tool that prevents sickness, saves lives, saves money and contributes to strong growth and strong communities





All of the benefits of immunisation at very little cost

Vaccinating an individual against up to 17 diseases throughout their entire life is estimated to cost **less than 3,400 Euros** in Europe – and this includes administrative costs.

Every Euro invested in adult vaccination (starting at age 50) yields **4 Euros of future economic revenue** over the remaining lifetime of the cohort




Many of the challenges we face are interconnected with the spread and rise of existing and new infectious diseases
