

III Facilitating uptake and ensuring wider deployment of eHealth

3. Skills and digital health literacy

From 2013, starting with the Competitiveness and Innovation Programme and continuing under Horizon 2020, the Commission will support activities aiming at increasing citizens' digital health literacy.

For professionals (health and scientific communities) the focus will be on developing evidence-based clinical practice guidelines for telemedicine services with particular emphasis on nursing and social care workers.

From a research perspective, EFN is involved in two just started **H2020 EU projects** on EU Electronic Health Records (EHR):

InteropEHRate & Smart4Health

providing end-user input in addressing key societal challenges such as people-centred care and prevention, as well as improving nurses' working conditions within integrated and continuity of care by embracing innovative technologies.

Interoperable EHRs at user edge (InteropEHRate)

Coordinated by Engineering Ingegneria Informatica (ENG - Italy).

Project objective: Realise an open, standardized and unique European extended-EHR and provide European citizens with a complete view of their health history, shareable with health operators and researchers.

The project works on three scenarios:

- Scenario 1 Device to Device (offline) data sharing
- Scenario 2 Emergency consultation of health data in the S-EHR cloud
- Scenario 3 Consultation by researchers of integrated and anonymised data

Duration of the project: 42 months. Started: 01-01-2019

Citizen-centred EU-EHR exchange for personalised health (Smart4Health)

Coordinated by UNINOVA – Instituto de Desenvolvimento de Novas Tecnologias (Portugal)

Project objective: To develop, test and validate a platform prototype for the smart4health citizen-centred health record with integrated ability for data donor ship to the scientific community, enabling citizens to manage, collect, access and share own health data.

This will pave the way for the full deployment of citizen-centred solutions and services in a digital single market for wellbeing and healthcare.

Duration of the project: 50 months. Started: 01-01-2019


